Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

Icons Festival 2019 is committed to working with the Licensing Authority and relevant agencies to meet all 4 Licensing objectives, to deliver a safe & successful event. The measures to be taken are outlined in full in the accompanying document 'Event Safety Plan', but are summarised in this application. We accept that the 'Event Safety Plan' will form part of the Licence conditions. Our event will feature 'Tribute' bands performing music from 1970's-1990's and we expect attendee's to be aged over 35. It is not an event that will attract groups of young people. Families are encouraged to attend with low price admission for accompanied children. Admissions & dispersal will be controlled/supervised

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Icons Festival 2019 is committed to a robust policy regarding any risk of crime, disorder and anti-social behaviour. We operate a zero tolerance policy in relation to Controlled drugs, Nitrous oxide, Weapons & anti-social behaviour. SIA trained Security/Event staff will be on duty throughout the event. At commencement of event there will be a minimum of 6 SIA Security on site & this minimum number will increase at a ratio of a further 4 SIA Security & 1 Event support staff per 1,000 attendees. A strict search policy will operate and is a condition of entry. CCTV will operate/record throughout the event, with both fixed and SIA Body-worn. The sale & consumption of alcohol will be strictly prohibited to persons under 18 years of age & we will operate 'Challenge 25' policy.

c) Public safety

Icons Festival 2019 Policy is to conduct our activities, so that, as far as is practicable, the Health & Safety of its employees, customers and any others that maybe affected by its activities is assured. Accordingly we have produced a detailed 'Event Safety Plan' (attached) and this will be reviewed at all stages and submitted to Elmbridge Licensing authority as agreed, and in any event 3 months prior to Icons Festival taking place. Traffic management will occur prior, during & after event to ensure public safety. All admissions will be controlled and supervised as will dispersal. There is an Evacuation Plan which is included in the 'Event Safety Plan'. We are committed to providing a safe & secure environment and to provide a fast & effective response should medical attention be required. An ambulance with paramedics, & SIA First Aiders will be on site to do this.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

As previously stated we will operate a zero-tolerance to anti-social behaviour. Persons attending and leaving the event will be asked to respect our neighbours and leave quietly by Security & Event Staff. In addition there will be conspicuous signage detailing the same. Traffic management will be adopted to minimise the impact on local residents due to increased traffic. I as applicant will apply to Elmbridge Borough Council for a Clearway policy during the event on Hurst Road from Waterside east towards Hampton Court. The music at the event although amplified will be controlled in line with limits agreed by Environmental Health prior to event and will be monitored to prevent limits being breached.

e) The protection of children from harm

Unaccompanied children are not permitted into the event. We are aware that we have a duty of care and are committed to the protection & safety of Children. Our safeguarding policy included in our 'Event Safety Plan'. All staff will be briefed in both dealing with lost and found children and taking reports of the same. The sale & consumption of alcohol will be strictly prohibited to persons under the age of 18 years.
